Report on University Admissions

The Fall 2013, Winter 2014, and Summer 2014 graduates of Marianopolis College were contacted and asked what they were doing for the 2014-2015 academic year. They were asked whether or not they were continuing their education and if they were, to specify the institution and program. Of the 924 graduates, information was obtained from 750 or 81.2% of the students. The following is a summary of the results of the survey:
